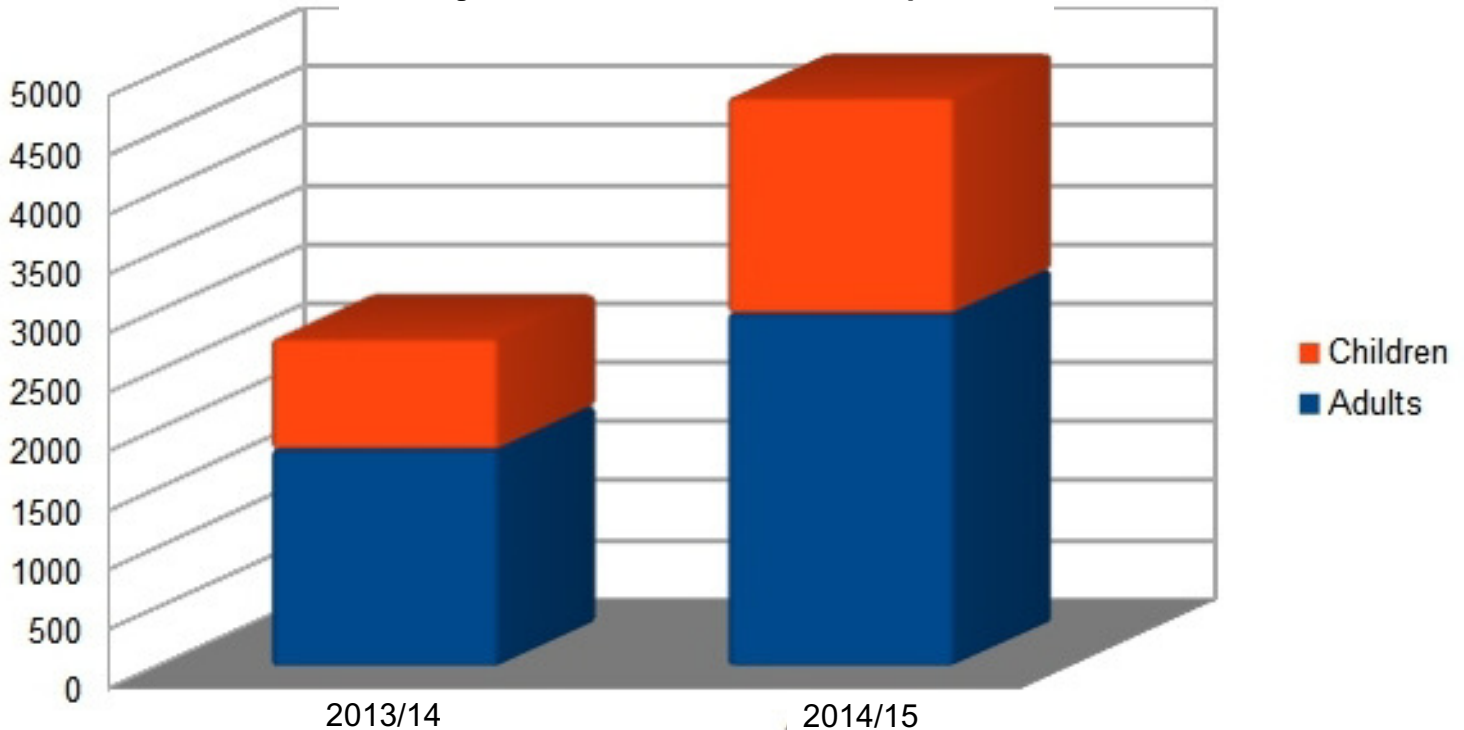


In this special edition we show how the work of the Southport Foodbank has grown since its inception two years ago. On the second page you might like to see the national picture of which we are a part.

The growth in our service - People fed



All this has been supported by an increase in the generosity of the local community and businesses in their donations.

Since we opened we have had 77 metric tons donated with the largest single month being last December when we dealt with 10 tons

Highest value donations are as follows:

Tesco customers – 20.02 tons

Formby churches together – 10.69 tons

Waitrose Formby customers – 5.38 tons

Asda Southport customers – 5.24 tons

Scarisbrick new road baptist – 2.21 tons

Ainsdale methodist 2.06 tons

In addition, anonymous donations from the general public, including members of the congregation leaving food at Lakeside amount to 6.90 tons.

The remaining 24.5 tons is split between a further 130+ donors - individuals, churches and businesses/.

We have also opened additional distribution centres in Banks and Formby and expanded our premises at Lakeside to provide additional capacity to handle the growth.

We remain immensely grateful to all who support us in our work, whether in food or monetary donations, as volunteers to deliver the service or by publicising the need through education and the local media.

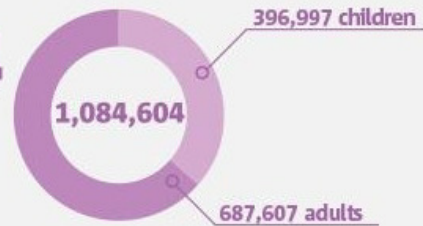

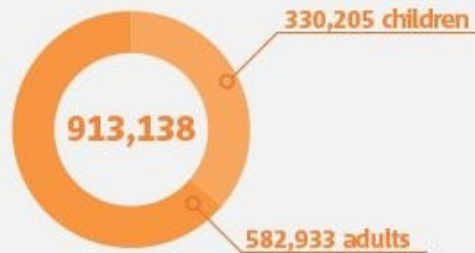

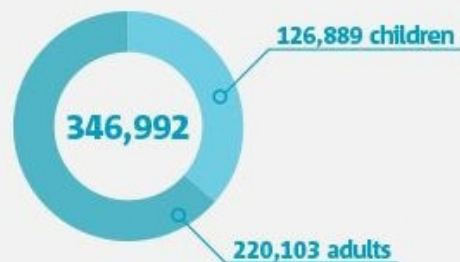
